Required language of instruction level: Level of Spanish (for those students taking courses in Spanish)\*

· General rule: B1 required, B2 recommended

· Specific rules: B2 required for the following studies:

As a general rule, students do not need to send their Spanish level certificate to UAM. It is the responsibility of the home university to select their students according to UAM linguistic requirements as mentioned above.

For these two Degrees nominated students will have to prove B2 level in Spanish with a DELE or SIELE certification.

Level of English (For those students taking courses in English):

B2 level of English is recommended (It is not necessary to send any certificate to UAM. It is the responsibility of the home university to select their students according to UAM linguistic requirements).

\*In general terms, the limited offer of courses taught in English means that exchange students must take part of their courses in Spanish and for this, they must have and prove (as stated above) a certain level of Spanish.
